DECLARATION OF CATHERINE NOWNES-WHITAKER CERTIFYING VOTING RESULTS WITH RESPECT TO THE SOLICITATION OF ACCEPTANCES REGARDING THE FIRST AMENDED CHAPTER 11 PLAN OF BAXANO SURGICAL, INC.

- I, Catherine Nownes-Whitaker, hereby declare that the following is true to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief:
 - 1. I am over the age of 18 and competent to testify and make this declaration (the "Declaration"). I am an employee of Rust Consulting/Omni Bankruptcy ("Rust Omni"). Pursuant to the orders of the Court entered on November 21, 2014 [D.I. 62] and July 1, 2015 [D.I. 534], the Debtor has retained and employed Rust Omni to provide certain claim, noticing and administrative services in the above-captioned chapter 11 case, including the collection and tabulation of ballots cast with respect to any plan of reorganization.
 - 2. Pursuant to the Order (I) Approving Disclosure Statement in Support of First Amended Chapter 11 Plan of Baxano Surgical, Inc.; (II) Establishing Record Dates; (III) Approving Solicitation Procedures, Forms of Ballots, and Manner of Notice; And (IV) Fixing the Date, Time, and Place For Confirmation Hearing

The last four digits of the Debtor's tax identification number are 9022. The Debtor's mailing address is P.O. Box 98386, Raleigh, North Carolina 27624.

and Deadline for Filing Objections Thereto [D.I. 496] (the "Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order"), Rust Omni was instructed to and did solicit and tabulate votes from holders of all claims entitled to vote on the First Amended Chapter 11 Plan Of Baxano Surgical, Inc. [D.I. 490] (the "Plan") in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order.

- 3. I am authorized to submit this Declaration on behalf of Rust Omni and the Debtor. Unless otherwise stated in this Declaration, I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein. As to statements of fact of which I do not have direct personal knowledge, I understand and believe them to be true based upon information gathered from other employees of Rust Omni, my review of relevant documents and Court pleadings, and information provided to me by the Debtor and the Debtor's advisors. If called upon as a witness, I could and would competently testify as to all of the matters stated herein on that basis
- 4. Pursuant to the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order, June 3, 2015 (the "Voting Record Date") was established as the last date for determining which creditors were entitled to vote on the Plan. Pursuant to the Plan, Holders³ of Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 Claims (collectively, the "Voting Classes") as of the Voting Record Date were entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan, except as otherwise provided by the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order. Rust Omni relied on the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order and the claims register it maintains in these chapter 11 cases, in consultation with

- counsel to the Debtor, to identify which Holders of Claims were entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan.
- 5. On June 10, 2015, in accordance with the solicitation procedures as set forth in the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order, Rust Omni served via first class mail packages (the "Solicitation Packages") on Holders of Claims in the Voting Classes entitled to accept or reject the Plan. See Affidavit of Service at D.I. 517.
- 6. In accordance with the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order, for a Ballot to be counted as valid, the Ballot must have been properly completed in accordance with the Disclosure Statement/Solicitation Procedures Order and executed by the holder, or such holder's authorized representative, and must have been received by Rust Omni by the deadline of July 10, 2015, at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Pacific Time) (the "Voting Deadline"). All completed Ballots were required to be mailed to Rust Consulting/Omni Bankruptcy, 5955 De Soto Ave., Suite 100, Woodland Hills, California 91367, which address was listed on the Ballots, so as to be received by Rust Omni no later than the Voting Deadline.
- 7. I was primarily responsible for supervising the employees of Rust Omni in connection with the tabulation of the Ballots received for the acceptance or rejection of the Plan. The pertinent information from the Ballots received from holders of Claims in Class 1, Class 2, and Class 3 (the "Counted Ballots") was recorded on the ballot tabulation reports attached hereto as Exhibit A, Exhibit B, and Exhibit C, respectively. Copies of all of the Counted Ballots are available for inspection upon request.
