


SAN ONOFRE Nuclear Power Plant vs.

Complaints of Safety Problems from On-Site Employees & Contractors*

January 2007 - December 2010



"The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) refers to these complaints as "Allegations from On-Site Sources" (current/former power plant employees/contractors and anonymous allegers). These are reports of impropriety or inadequacy of NRC-related safety or regulatory concerns. This chart includes the number of on-site allegations filed with the NRC. However, each allegation may contain multiple complaints. The multiple complaint count is not included on this chart. Also, an allegation about a safety-conscious work environment (SCWE) problem at a facility is important. How ever, a Notice of Violation cannot be issued, because there is no applicable NRC regulation. Note: There are 64 nuclear power plants; the majority have more than one reactor for a total of 104 reactors in the U.S. Source: www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/allegations/statistics.html
